



Special Enrollment Period for Residents with Lower Income

Access Health CT is committed to increasing access to affordable health insurance coverage. This Special Enrollment Period for Residents with Lower Income will provide access to no-cost or very low-cost health insurance made possible by the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA).

Who is eligible for the Special Enrollment Period for Residents with Lower Income?

- New or returning customers who are not currently enrolled in a health insurance plan through Access Health CT
- Connecticut residents who are eligible for Advance Premium Tax Credits (APTCs) and have a household income at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)

Here is a chart that can help you understand if you meet the income requirements:

Household Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
150% FPL	\$22,590.00	\$30,660.00	\$38,730.00	\$46,800.00	\$54,870.00	\$62,940.00	\$71,010.00	\$79,080.00

Important notes about availability:

- Offered only through Access Health CT as Connecticut's official health insurance exchange
- The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) makes health insurance coverage more affordable and accessible for many Connecticut residents by greatly reducing monthly payments (premiums) for many people who enroll through Access Health CT
- Coverage will start on the first of the month following enrollment
